Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ –

I am writing to you to provide notice of a proposed change to the bylaws of the Golden Gate Association to be discussed and voted upon at our Fall Gathering at San Carlos Community UCC, 1336 Arroyo Ave., on October 23, 2010 at 11:00 am.

The Proposed Change:

ARTICLE VI. Section 1. A of the GGA bylaws provides:

“Elected officers of the Association shall be the Board of Directors, which shall elect a Moderator and a Vice Moderator. There shall be twelve (12) Directors selected so that they are as equally representative of northern and southern areas as is practicable, and as equally representative of the ministry and laity as is practicable”.

The recommended change will add the words “a minimum of” before the number “12”, in order to allow the GGA Board to have more than 12 Directors.

Rationale:

As a volunteer organization with no paid staff, the work of the Association is done in large part by the Directors of the GGA. The GGA Board of Directors is a working Board. The more qualified active and engaged Directors we have on the Board, the more hands we will have to do the work of the Association. The Golden Gate Association has an abundance of resources. We are blessed with more talented and capable individuals who are willing to serve as Directors than we have positions available. We seek to take advantage of this richness in resources in order to ensure that we continue to support the ministries of the Association as effectively as possible. Accordingly the GGA Board seeks to expand the number of its Directors beyond the 12 enumerated in our current bylaws.
